#### **Accessibility and Expansion Project Update**

A lot has been happening during the past month! It has been a great learning experience for our team of Library Trustees and myself as we work our way through this project. We are so excited to make this building more accessible to all of our community members. These next few months are going to be pretty big for us. Here is our current projected timeline:

June: The project is open for bid.

**July 19th**: Bids for the project are due by 2pm at Naples Library.

**End of July**: Contractors for the project are chosen.

September-October: Break ground
October 2022-May 2023: Construction

Stay tuned for a special public event we will be hosting in early September where we will discuss project details, impact and have Q & A. Our plan is to keep our library as open as possible during the construction phase, but you can expect some differences in hours and possible closures when the work being done would make the building unsafe for patrons and staff. We will have those details soon. And don't forget, if you have any questions in regards to this project, don't hesitate to reach out!
