Since the completion of our Accessibility and Expansion Project, our Board of Trustees has been hard at work recruiting new members and working on our 2025-2028 Long Range Plan. This year we welcome Katy Matthews, Tim Williams and Brooke **Finley** as our newest Trustees. We are also saying farewell to Paul Lambiase, Kim Torpey and Deidre Dutcher as their terms will end in June. Their contributions were many, and we will miss them greatly from our team.
